The NYTTL is not only a league, is all about organization. A whole process involving delegates from clubs, players, regulations, schedules, etc. The league has no owner, no profits, and our main goal is finding the best club in the northeast region. In the last meeting the League Director Mauricio Vergara was confirmed in his position, Jose Hernandez was appointed as Director of Regulations replacing to Harvey Vasquez. Thank you Harvey!! Using a random process was assigned a number to each club and in base of that the schedule was finished. Delegates decided an extension of the deadlines in order to receive new entries; unfortunately some clubs couldn't make it on time. But next season will starts in 2011.

**What is next ?** During the last year we have been working in the base, learning to work as a team, delegates representing clubs and being the link between the league and the players. This is the base of any professional league. The next step was the National Finals, and we did it last year working again with other leagues...So now we will work to have the **FIRST WORLD LEAGUE FINALS IN NEW YORK**, with all champions from the most important leagues around the world.....We will do it , you will see.
